12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
13	2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
14	SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 3 of Article V of the Oklahoma
15	Constitution, there is hereby ordered the following legislative
16	referendum which shall be filed with the Secretary of State and
17	addressed to the Governor of the state, who shall submit the same to
18	the people for their approval or rejection at the next General
19	Election.
20	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.192, is
21	amended to read as follows:
22	Section 1210.192. Any minor child, through the parent,
23	guardian, or legal custodian of the child, may submit to the health

3	$\frac{1.}{A}$ a certificate of a licensed physician as defined in
4	Section 725.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, stating that the

6	endanger the life or health of the child ; or
7	2. A written statement by the parent, guardian or legal
8	custodian of the child objecting to immunization of the child;
9	whereupon the child shall be exempt from the immunization laws of
10	this state.
11	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective upon approval by the
12	people.
13	SECTION 4. The Ballot Title for the proposed act shall be in
14	the following form:

16	Legislative Referendum No State Question No
17	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
18	This measure would amend 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.192, which
19	relates to exemptions for immunizations. It would remove the
20	non-medical exemption from the requirement that all minor
21	children be immunized against certain diseases before being
22	admitted to any public, private or parochial school.
